



Depending on your vehicle model, the sink shelf is either removable or sliding.









Bed

4 spars



6 crosspieces (4 shorts and 2 longs)




2 central panels




4 long legs for the bed and 8 screws



4 short legs for the bed (if needed)



2 driver panels





List of Necessary Tools

Before you begin, you will need:

• A Phillips screwdriver

Installation Steps for the DUO Camping Kit



1. Lower the rear seats of the vehicle.



2. Check the minimum height required to open the kit by placing a bracket in the deep part of the vehicle, at the edge of the trunk.



To install the brackets of the kitchen unit, open the drawer so that you can access the two latches on the sides. Press both latches while pulling on the drawer. Then remove the drawer





3. Flip the kitchen unit and the small cabinet onto the floor to see the four slots needed for the legs' installation. Place on a clean blanket to prevent damage

3.1 Using a screwdriver, install and adjust the height of the legs for both the kitchen unit and the small cabinet. Use 2 screws per leg.



3.2 Attach the 6 legs (4 on the kitchen unit, 2 on the small cabinet). Ensure they are securely attached before flipping the kitchen unit back over.

While adjusting your legs, ensure that they all have support in the vehicle and that the kit is level



3.3 Flip the kitchen unit back over, legs facing down.

Reinstall the drawer by aligning the two sliders. Put the drawer back in.

To help you properly reinsert the sliders, hold the sliders of the cabinet and push the drawer. A click should be heard on each side. Resistance is possible when replacing the drawer. However, once completely closed, your drawer will no longer have resistance.





4. Using a screwdriver, secure the 4 vehicle attachment straps. Attach 2 straps outside the small cabinet and 2 straps outside the kitchen unit.

The goal is to create a tension angle to secure the modules in the vehicle.



4.1 Using a screwdriver, attach the two straps to the boxes. One inside the small box and one inside the kitchen box, near the front panels.











5. Using a screwdriver, secure the small cabinet to the connecting piece. For this, place the cabinet face down on a clean blanket to prevent damage.

5.1 Lift the pivot part of the connecting piece, then screw this piece onto the back face of the small cabinet. You will need 4 screws and 4 washers.

Ensure that the small cabinet is securely attached to the connecting piece before installing it in the vehicle.

Vehicle Installation



- 6. Install the small cabinet and the connecting piece in the vehicle
- 6.1 Then, install the kitchen unit at the right end of the connecting piece.



6.2 Using a screwdriver, secure the kitchen unit to the connecting piece. You will need 4 screws and 4 washers.





6.3 Fit the 'E' piece under the two front legs of the cabinets, then attach the cabinet attachment straps. (Only SUV)



6.4 Attach the straps to the vehicle's anchors.


Check that the tailgate closes well. If needed, move the conversion kit a few centimeters.



6.5 Tighten the four straps to the vehicle's anchor points. The straps should be angled like the one in the image. This way, both the small cabinet and the kitchen unit will not move and will be secured.



Bed Module



7. Using a screwdriver, install and adjust the height of the legs of the bed module according to your vehicle model.

While adjusting your legs, ensure that they all have support on the folded seats and that the bed is level.



8. Insert the 4 spares (2 for solo). For this, raise the pivot part of the kitchen module's connecting piece

Be careful not to force the hinges.



8.1 Fit the toothed part of the spar into the long slot of the connecting piece. Move the spar laterally in the smaller slot to lock the spar.





8.2 Lift the pivot part of the bed module's connecting piece and insert a long crosspiece.



9. Insert the second long crosspiece into the notches of the rails.



9.1 Insert the 4 crosspieces into the notches of the rails. Note, there is a wide side and a short side, the wide side goes on the outside of the bed.



9.2 Fit the notches of the spar into the movable part of the connecting piece.





10. Install the 4 panels (2 for solo) that make up the bed base. To do this, install the panels in the notches of the spars. Start with the central panels.



Repeat for the driver panels.



11. Ensure that the bed module and cabinets are straight. Readjust the legs as needed.

All that's left is to install your mattress!

Your kit is now ready for use.

If your module makes noise on the road, it means it is improperly installed. Please review each step again.



Opening the Drawers



The kitchen unit has a locking system to prevent it from opening while driving. To open it, insert your finger into the hole, press the black plastic piece to the left while pulling the drawer by the handle.

Recommanded Use

- 1. Maximum recommended weight of 220 pounds per person.
- 2.Do not exceed the load capacity of the drawers (100lbs).
- 3. Sit on a mattress, not directly on the wooden platform.
- 4. When installed in the vehicle, ensure the kit is securely fastened with straps to secure the module.
- 5. When uninstalling the module, we recommend disassembling the kitchen unit from the connecting piece before removing it from the vehicle.
- 6.Do not leave your fingers in the hatch openings when opening or closing the drawers.
- 7. When storing, keep in a dry and flat place.
- 8.If you are adjusting the legs, ensure they all have support in the vehicle and that the bed is level.
